Kyle and Tracy Bunch, owners of Puterbaugh, were leasing their current location at 409 E 5th Street, Grandview, WA from the trust of the company's previous owner. When the beneficiaries of the trust decided to sell the property, Puterbaugh researched their financing options and found the SBA 504 loan program met their needs to purchase the property. Because the program allowed 90% financing on their multi-purpose building, the company's equity injection was just 10% of the project allowing them to retain liquidity for bonding and other upfront general contractor costs. In addition the fixed rate, 20-year term helped them to stabilize occupancy expenses and allow for future growth.


